We are thrilled to open registration for the New England Chapter of the American Public Works Association's annual Summer Conference. Two steps are needed to attend:

1. Reserve your accommodations

Due to a change in management, room reservations close early this year. Visit <http://newengland.apwa.net> to access the online booking link. **Accommodations must be reserved no later than May 15, 2022.** A "standard accommodation" room is available for \$175 per night. There is a 10 day cancellation policy for individual room cancellations. If individual rooms are cancelled 10 days or more in advance of the arrival, funds will be refunded less a \$25/room cancellation fee. Guest payments will be forfeited in the event of cancellation within 10 days of the scheduled arrival.

2. Register for the conference
