The City also offers a [Trainee Program](#) that allows candidates that may not have the necessary licensure requirements to obtain a permanent position within the Framingham Department of Public Works. Candidates must have their Commercial Driver's License Permit (CDL) and demonstrate the attitude and aptitude for the position. Candidates selected for the program will receive an offer of employment, with an agreement to obtain the required CDL and hoisting licensure within six months. The City works with and "sponsors" trainees in the program to help them obtain the required licenses.
