- Coordinates the design/construction of public works projects: water, sewer and roads.
- Prepares specifications for service contracts for public infrastructure projects.
- Conducts inspections of public works projects and ensures compliance with all state and federal regulations affecting public works operations.
- Acts as liaison with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation and the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, and other state and federal agencies.
- Assist with the mapping and asset management requirements as assigned. Mapping and Geographic Information Systems (GIS): to include streets, sidewalks, water/sewer/stormwater drainage, and other City infrastructure.
