Foreman: Under the direction of the Director of Public Works/WPCA Administrator or his designee, plans, outlines and performs work from order and knowledge of project and available equipment; reports work in progress and/or upon completion and results obtained. Oversees work crews in the construction, repair and maintenance of Town roads, bridges and wastewater collection system, pumping stations, flow metering stations, etc. Supervises and performs skilled and semiskilled work in operating and maintaining vehicles and heavy construction equipment. May assume responsibilities in the absence of the Director of Public Works/WPCA Administrator or his designee. Works with considerable independence. Prepares reports as specified by the Director of Public Works/WPCA Administrator or his designee.

Qualifications: Graduation from high school or equivalent supplemented by semi-skilled trades training and three to five (3-5) years of related experience in operating heavy equipment, road construction, repair and maintenance work; three to four (3-4) years of experience in wastewater collection systems; including two (2) years of supervisory or crew leader experience, or equivalent combination of education, training and experience.

Must possess a Connecticut P-6 Limited Sewer, Storm and Water Journeyman License; or ability to obtain within one year of employment.

Must possess a valid Connecticut Commercial Driver's License (CDL), Class A.
