This position performs work related to the installation, maintenance and repair of public water distribution systems for commercial, residential and public properties. The Water Service Technician not only operates heavy machinery but performs a full range of complex tasks and works within established procedures and/or policies. At this level, the incumbent serves as secondary Drinking Water License Operator and works with occasional instruction or assistance. Work involves frequent interpretation of policies, procedures and guidelines, and may involve the development of recommendations consistent with directives, policies and regulations.
