Examples of Duties: Performs a wide variety of manual and mechanical duties to maintain and repair town vehicles, machinery and equipment. Develops preventative maintenance schedules, inspects, troubleshoots, diagnoses malfunctions, performs maintenance and safety inspections, repairs or replaces defective parts, components or systems; uses test equipment, hand/power tools, uses cutting tools and welder when fabricating parts; maintains inventories, orders parts, etc. Required to participate in the Town's snow and ice removal operations.

Education and Experience: HS/GED, Trade School, Associates Degree in automotive or diesel technology, and/or Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification highly preferred; minimum of 2 years full time work experience in a comparable position, or an equivalent combination of education and experience to acquire the desired skills and knowledge; Requires Class B CDL w/ Air Brake (Class A preferred); 2-A, 4E & 4G Hoisting Licenses (to be obtained within 6 months of hire); must have the strength & stamina required to work with heavy equipment and work in awkward positions; subject to DOT Drug and Alcohol testing;
