Compensation: Union position, current range \$18.68 TO \$22.57 (Under Negotiation), full benefits package

Hours: 40 hours per week, Mon – Fri 7:00 am to 3:30 pm (1/2 hour unpaid lunch, two paid breaks); overtime required; extra pay for standby

Location: 2721 Boston Road, DPW Building

Examples of Duties: Responsible for assisting in the operation and maintenance of the wastewater collection system and pump station infrastructure. The employee is required to perform Town wide snow and ice removal operations as well as assist in the completion of other Public Works projects. Performs confined space entry, sewer manhole and pipe repair, pump station inspections and related equipment maintenance; performs manual labor and operates 26,000 GVW trucks, backhoe, front-end loader, jet vacuum truck, crane, snow plow, and other equipment used to excavate, haul, or load earth and other materials; Must work overtime to respond to wastewater emergencies and man-made or weather related emergencies.

Education: High School or GED; Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class B with airbrake and tanker endorsement; Must obtain and maintain within 1 year of hire Wastewater Collection System Operator Certification Grade 2 and MA Hoisting Engineer's Licenses (1B, 2B & 4E)

Experience: Minimum 3 years (all seasons) full time experience operating heavy equipment and wastewater pump station maintenance. Must pass DOT physical and drug testing. Must pass the Criminal Offender Records Inquiry.
