

Town of Williston Job Classification Description

WATER/SEWER TECHNICIAN Grade 3

BASIC FUNCTION

To perform a variety of tasks related to the maintenance and repair of the Town water distribution and sewage collection systems. Assist with general public works activities as needed.

CHARACTERISTICS, DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Check, maintain, troubleshoot problems with, and repair sewer lines and pump stations, and water distribution lines and pumps not maintained by the Champlain Water District.
- Inspect new construction of water and sewer services, ensuring compliance with relevant codes.
- Inspect new residential construction for compliance with Certificates of Occupancy.
- Read water meters four times per year.
- Install new meters and repair malfunctioning meters.
- Keep water and sewer maps and other documentation updated.
- Perform light maintenance on small power equipment, light trucks and Town vehicles.
- Install, paint, flush, and repair hydrants; cut grass and shovel snow to keep hydrants accessible.
- Assist in responding to customer problems or complaints.
- Plow and remove snow as needed.
- Assist as needed with other Public Works functions, such as plowing and sanding/salting in winter, grounds and street work in summer, and the like.
- Keep current on water and sewer industry standards.
- Participate in the water and sewer rotational on-call program.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Moderate supervision is received from the Water/Sewer Foreman.

QUALIFICATIONS

Basic education (high school) plus two to three years of relevant work experience, or a combination of education and experience from which comparable knowledge and skills are acquired.

- Good basic mechanical skills, with good working knowledge of pumps/plumbing. Ability to use a variety of handtools. Directly related experience in water systems operations desirable.
- Basic reading, writing and math skills.
- Valid Vt. CDL Driver's license, ability to drive a truck.
- Physical ability to perform all job duties.
- The ability to acquire a Vermont Public Water Systems Operators License (Class D) within 24 months of hire.
